

However, love and happiness exist within this chaos, which evokes laughter and excitement. Emma and Lisa's adventure will surely invite a reader in.



The new book by Oksana Drachkovska, *The Baby Hare Who Didn't Jump and His Brave Mom* is an autobiographical story and a fairy tale. We meet Nazarko, who is a child living with a disability. Unfortunately, he has been unable to walk since his childhood. Every day his mother Oksana fights for the better future for all people with disabilities including her little son.

The book tells kids that not all people are the same. It explains how important it is not to give up when life gives you a hard time, it feels like you have no strength left, and you don't know how to live in the world that seems to be aimed for so-called ordinary people. It is a light, interesting, colorful story that will definitely give you hope and make you smile.

Oksana Drachkovska is a writer, journalist and public activist working both in newspapers and on TV. She is the author of two novels and a play "Christmas" that received the first prize of the International Literary Competition "Koronatsiya Slova". *The Baby Hare Who Didn't Jump and His Brave Mom* was also recognised as the best inclusive story in this competition.






THE PLACE FOR THE DRAGON




DOGGY AND DOG: OUR BUSINESS JOG

HOW TO MAKE MONEY DURING THE HOLIDAYS

Rusya is about to turn eleven. She dreams of a new phone and a festive party on a ship. But her father's coffee shop is on the verge of bankruptcy. So, together with her friends, the girl tries to earn enough money to fulfill her dreams. The children find parttime jobs, publish a newspaper, set up a fund, start a vlog, and invest... in a coffee shop. Rusya manages to raise the necessary amount of money, but her desires change.

Reading the story of Rusya and her friends, children will learn about finances, business, minting money, cryptocurrencies, the work of an investment fund, the danger of loans and the risks of gambling, pyramid schemes, types of advertising, sales as well as about how to save money. Students will get acquainted with such concepts as competition, business collaboration, monopoly, competitive intelligence, profit, investment, capital. Each chapter reveals a new problem and explains its economic significance using an example from Rusya's life.




